Yunxu Pavilion (雲旭樓) is a designated historical site in Yunlin County. It was originally built as a school building for Yunlin Junior High School and follows the architectural standards of the nine-year compulsory education school buildings. Its construction bears witness to the significant role of nine-year compulsory education in the Douliu area. After Yunlin Junior High School relocated, the county government entrusted this building to YunTech, where it is managed by the Cultural Heritage Preservation Department for educational purposes related to cultural heritage. It also serves as a community college education center and a venue for exhibitions. It is open to the public for free visits.

The local government handed over this building to YunTech in 2022. In response to the National Heritage Day in 2023, YunTech organized a series of events for "2023 Yunxu Pavilion Heritage Day", including student achievement exhibitions, workshops, heritage tours, lectures, heritage forums and banquets, etc., which kicked off the revitalization of the Yunxu Pavilion.
